RUDE!



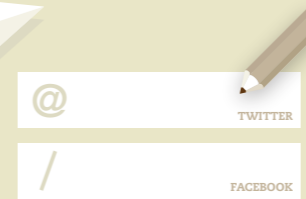
4 No making Skype calls without a headset
